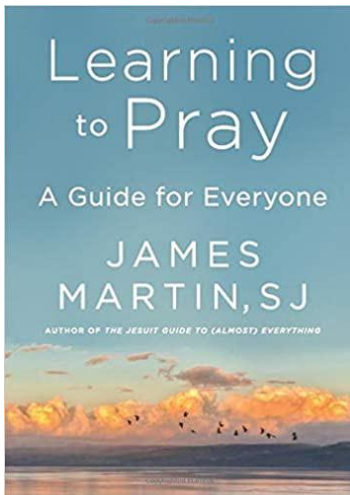
Choir Practice
