#### FROM THE PASTOR...A Roll of the Dice?

If anyone makes the claim that we should follow the scriptural story in our practice of faith and church that person is going to run into some dicey situations. This coming Sunday's text of Acts one would be a good case in point. (continued on page 2...)

The disciples are faced with the task of replacing Judas. They decide that the replacement must be a person who accompanied them with Jesus, and they narrow it down to two. First, there's a man known as Justus, and then there's Matthias. Both are acceptable options, and they must decide between the two. They decide that the choice is to be made by the "casting of lots," essentially the random tossing of stones.

To us, the random casting of stones or rolling of dice is simply chance. But to the ancients, this was a way to reveal the will of God. And while I do believe the rolling of dice is random, I also believe that through this practice in Acts 1 Matthias was called to service in the Community.

God calls us in many different ways. Some of those ways may seem random, and some may seem deliberate. But either way, the call of God comes. This Sunday in worship we will consider how God calls, and what God may be calling us (and you) to do for God and the Church.


