# **Re-Gathering in the Sanctuary** August 2 at 11:00 a.m.

What We Are Doing Together to Keep You Safe.

This is a brief overview of what you can expect when we come together in August. Most specifically: what we are doing together to keep you safe. We hope this will help you in making your decision about returning to sanctuary worship. We will continue to offer an on-line church service for those who do not feel comfortable returning to church at this time.

- 1. Everyone will be wearing face coverings. The best thing to do is to put on your mask even before you exit your car to enter the church. If you do not have a mask, there will be some at the entry table for you.
- 2. We will be using only one entrance. Please enter and exit through the sanctuary doors. There will be a handicap

entrance through the fover for those who are unable to enter or exit by the stairs. Attendants will be there to help you at the doors.

- 3. We will be doing a quick temperature scan. As you approach the entrance of the church one of our nurses will use a non-contact thermometer to get your temperature. This will assure us there is no one who enters the church having a fever. The quick read thermometer is aimed at the individual and can assess their temperature within seconds.
- 4. We will be social distancing. When you enter the church, the ushers will escort you to a designated seating area. They will begin seating at the front of the sanctuary and fill from the front to the back. Families will be able to sit together. We are doing it this way so that those sitting on the aisle will not be close to those walking in or out. At the end of the service, the ushers will guide everyone out, starting at the back row. - 5. Worship material will be on the screens. Also, bulletins will be emailed on Thursday if you would like to print one out. The bulletin will also be available by QR code as you enter the church to view on your iphone or other device. There will be no paper bulletins distributed at the church. You are encouraged to bring your Bible as there will not be Bible's or Hymnals in the pews.
- 6. Please use the bathrooms that are near the foyer. There will be restroom attendants at the bathrooms to open the door for you and to monitor the amount of people using the bathroom.
- 7. An offering plate will be available as you exit the church.

We look forward to gathering together to worship with you, whether it be in person or online. Wherever you worship from, please know that God gathers there with you.

You do not need a reservation but if you plan on coming would you please let us know by calling the church office before 2:00 p.m. on Thursday?
