From the Pastor... Blessing of Backpacks?

On Sunday, August 22 we will have our annual "blessing of the backpacks" during worship. Don't misunderstand, we will not be praying for *backpacks*. Rather, we will be praying for the students who carry those backpacks into our schools during this coming academic year.




Wednesday Night Activities Returning in September!


